Topics covered will include Jewish Refugees from Nazism, World War II Military Intelligence (as seen on 60 Minutes), and today's Ukraine Conflict and how it all fits together. Dr. David Frey is Professor of History and Founding Director of the Center for Holocaust & Genocide Studies (CHGS) at the US Military Academy at West Point.
