## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Pool Party

As of now the 7<sup>th</sup> grade trip is set for Monday. Students should bring towels and lunch or money for lunch. There will be locker rooms at the Stonybrook Swim Club in Hillsdale so students can come dressed in swimwear or bring it and change at the club. It would be smart for each student to bring a string bag for personal items. There will be water and sunscreen provided, but I recommend each student brings their own preferred sunscreen. Lifeguards will be on duty, but please speak to your students about avoiding the deep end if they are unable to swim. **IF... the event must be postponed due to weather, it will be Friday. The decision will be made Sunday afternoon and will be shared on Instagram (@riverdell\_middleschool), by an automated phone call, and through email. If you do not hear from RDMS, the trip will remain on Monday.**
